After shooting over 100 commercials, including award-winners in New York and Auckland, I now focus on creating high-rating, visually exciting and emotive documentaries in genres that range from cinematic events to Leading-edge Techniques intimate portraits.

Consistently I make films that receive Critic's Choice.

I've directed a feature doc selected at TIFF and Boulder, two of the highestever rated documentaries for Animal Planet, short films for CNN that have won the prestigious Peabody Award, and I'm widely praised for both my storytelling skills and my distinctive visual approach.

In recent years my documentaries have been shortlisted for RTS, BAFTA, Banff and Televisual awards.
